

A HELPING HAND WOULD BE WELCOME

One of the guiding principles of community radio broadcasting in Australia is the one which believes that a common interest shared by a group of people does exist and that this interest will be reflected in programs that are broadcast. To ensure that this does happen members of the community are encouraged to participate in a radio station's decision-making process and operations.

One of the best ways of making this happen is through a system of subcommittees and this is where you may be able to help. Capital Community Radio has always welcomed volunteers willing to join a subcommittee. Your involvement would only occupy a few hours each week or even less than that in some cases. And the hours spent can be quite interesting.

To give you some idea of how you might be able to participate, here is the list of subcommittees and their functions which plan and operate Capital Community Radio's broadcasting schedule.

Programming and Volunteer Coordination - Ensures the station's program policy is maintained the management of volunteer's participation

Technical - Qualified volunteers carry out the maintenance of all of the station's technical operations

Finance - Ensures that the station's financial matters are conducted in accordance with all legal requirements and are fully accountable.

Sponsorship - Promotes the station to prospective sponsors to assist revenue raising.

Training - Conducts a program encompassing all aspects of preparing volunteers to become Presenters and Producers of the station's programs.

Rules - Ensures that the station observes all the codes of conduct and legal conditions that apply to a community radio stations licence.

Events - Plans a year-long calendar of events such as open days, outside broadcasts and community activity that the station participates in each year.

Secretary - Assists the station with secretarial duties.

Media - Preparation of quarterly newsletter and information-based segments for broadcast.
